

**BAM Spring colored pencil class info:  
Tuesdays, May 12 - June 16, 9:30 to Noon**

Materials List:

- Set of at least 48 colored pencils I recommend Prismacolor Premier as they are the easiest to work with. However, larger sets of pencils are better for a good variety of color. Students may choose to bring another brand especially if they already own some. Careful with student grade, they contain more binder and less pigment making it more difficult to build up colors.
  - White or off white drawing paper such as Legion Stonehenge, Canson, Strathmore Drawing Paper. Can be individual sheets or pad, we won't work larger than 11x14". (sometimes Job Lot has decent drawing pads & sketch pads)
  - Small sketch pad for thumbnails or trying out colors. Doesn't have to be new, can be something students already own.
  - Standard lead pencil for outlining image
  - Kneaded eraser
  - Pencil sharpener; handheld or battery operated
  - Ruler
  - Hard board to work on (surface to work on in case the tables are textured)
- \*\*Kendra will bring extra surfaces to experiment on, still life objects, handouts, extra supplies.
